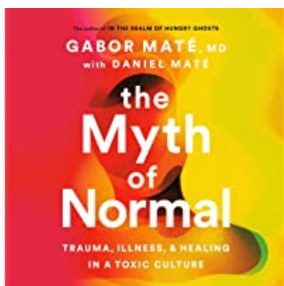

In some wealthier countries, the sale of published books has decreased due to the increased use of e-books.

In the 2000s, as a result of growth in availability of affordable handheld computing devices, the chance to share texts through electronic means became an attractive alternative for media publishers. The expression e-book is a contraction of "digital book"; it pertains to a book-length publication in electronic form. An e-book is generally made accessible through the internet, but also on CD-ROM and other forms. E-Books might be read either using a computing device with an LED display like a traditional computer, a smartphone or a tablet computer; or by way of a mobile e-ink display device known as an e-book reader, such as the Sony Reader, Barnes & Noble Nook, Kobo eReader, or even the Amazon Kindle. E-book readers try to mimic the experience of reading a print publication by using this technology, because the displays onto e-book readers are much less reflective.
